Five years ago, a very pregnant lab mix was abandoned at an illegal dump on the creek bank, left to deliver her pups amongst the garbage. Born under the roots of an old tree, on the slope of the bank surrounded in trash, a little yellow lab pup and his littermates lived contentedly as their mom nearly starved to death trapped in the tree roots by the never ending cycle of waste dumped upon them. It was almost magic that allowed RockySpot to even find them, much less get them out. Once safely carried away from the rubbish, the black lab mom was named Wendy and all her pups were called names from Peter Pan, including Tinkerbell and the lost boys. All members of the family quickly found homes and we thought "Neverland" was behind them and they would never see it again... but as Wendy once said, "Never is a very long time."

Tragically, last month two of the Lost Boys were abandoned at the shelter after a new human baby was born into their home. Facing a fate worse than a trash-filled Neverland, RockySpot brought Dakota and Bear (formerly known as Nibs and Twin) back safely to the rescue only to discover the two are bonded so tightly they can never be separated. Who can blame them after all they have been through? The love between these two dogs is touching and enchanting. Unfortunately both dogs are in danger again. 

The consensus is that she is in a lot of pain and is very stoic about it. My friend who is a physical therapist is going to evaluate Sugar Bear to see what we can do to alleviate pain and increase strength in her legs. The good news is that her blood work looked great, and she is gaining strength at a remarkable pace. She started out not walking more than several feet at a time before falling or having to take a break.

She is already up to 3 city blocks every night with only one or two rests. She is a serious witch about her walks too! She knows she goes after Sydney comes back to the dog room and you about can't get Sydney put back with Sugar's pushing out the gate!!! I'm stunned she wants to walk at all. I put her out front one night just to let her sniff something new and she started off down the driveway so I just went with her and now every night she gets cranky about getting her turn. Very cute:) She's eating fairly well. She has the softest fur. It feels so good to pet her.










STATUS QUO in Court






"NADIA" Senior Female, White with Black Dalmation, 50 lbs.



"RODNEY" Senior Male, White with Black, Dalmation


